Tasks

Main Duties and Responsibilities :

- Provide vehicle transport capability within the Mission;
- Provision and maintenance of the vehicle fleet;
- Manage the fleet in accordance with the decisions made by headquarters and the mission;
- Follow up on the acquisition, receipt, distribution, maintenance, utilization and disposal of the vehicle fleet;
- Ensure that the mission's vehicles are used in accordance with African Union Rules and Regulations;
- Review the update of data on vehicle usage;
- Arrange for testing staff and issuance of driving permits

Requirements

1. Qualifications and Experiences Required:

Masters in mechanical engineering, transportation, logistics, administration, management or similar fields and 7 years relevant work experience of which 3 years at a supervisory level in a related field with Government, NGO, think tank, or similar multi lateral, regional or international institution.

Bachelors degree in mechanical engineering, transportation, logistics, administration, management or similar fields and 10 years relevant work experience in field with Government, NGO, think tank, or similar multi lateral, regional or international institution.

2. Skills and Competencies Required:

- Computer literate and well versed in the use of the Internet, Power Point, Excel and Word.
- Demonstrates ability to manage diverse transport operations
- Ability to review alternative options and select most effective and cost efficient mode of transport
- Ability to work in a multicultural setting
- Must be prepared to work in a hardship context and highly pressurized and sometimes hazardous environment

3. Language requirement:

Proficiency in one of the African Union working languages (Arabic, English, French and Portuguese) is required. Knowledge of one or more of the other AU working languages would be an added advantage.

4. Tenure of appointment:

The appointment shall be for an initial period of one (1) year, the first three (3) months of which shall be on probation. It shall be renewable subject to performance and availability of funds.
