Project

Job Purpose:

The AU Medical and Health Services (MHSD) is an outpatient polyclinic undergoing gradual transformation to a modern outpatient-inpatient facility. It provides preventive and curative services to the AU Staff, their eligible dependents, African Diplomats accredited to Ethiopia and the AU, AU Consultants and Delegates to AU meetings and Summits. The MHSD has recently enhanced its service delivery systems by acquiring state of the art diagnostic equipment including radio imaging equipment at the Radiology, ENT and Dental Unit respectively.

Tasks

Major Duties and Responsibilities:

A Radiology Technician is targeted to fill this position. Under the supervision of the Head of Division Medical Support Services, the Radiology Technician will be responsible for the following:

- Receive patients, accept the request through the Integrated Medical Record System and perform different X-Ray examinations;
- Able to use the Picture Archiving System
- Able to operate Fluoroscope, CR, Panoramic Dental X-Ray, Mammography, CT Scan and MRI.
- Prepare patients for the required special examinations such as IVP, etc. by giving them the proper instructions and colonic lavage (cleansing enema) when necessary;
- Assist the radiologist in fluoroscopic examinations.
- Check the stock and request for items that the unit needs;
- Give the required attention and care to the equipment as required by the manufacturer.
- To perform any other relevant duties assigned by the immediate Supervisor.

Requirements

1. Educational Qualifications and Work Experience Required:

- University Diploma in Radiography with 8 years of experience as X-Ray Technician and Advanced operation of Radio Imaging Equipment's such as Panoramic Dental X-Ray, Mammography, CT Scan, MRI and Bone scanner is an added advantage. Candidates must be licensed to practice as X-Ray Technician in his/her country as at the time of application and Experience/exposure as an X-Ray Technician in an international organization or practice in a multicultural context will be an advantage

2. Required Skills and Competencies:

- Must be computer literate and have excellent use of continuous medical education tools including internet based ones.
- Must have hands on experience/ exposure to telemedicine.
- Must have excellent interpersonal skills, ability to organize and motivate others, and work in a multicultural environment,
- Must have good communication skills with patients, colleagues and the clients.

3. Language Requirement:

Proficiency in one of the African Union working languages (Arabic, English, French and Portuguese) is required. Knowledge of one or more of the other AU working languages would be an added advantage.

4. Tenure of Appointment:

The appointment will be on a fixed term contract for a period of three (3) years, of which the first twelve (12) months will be considered as a probationary period. Thereafter, the contract will be for a period of two (2) years renewable, subject to satisfactory performance.

5. Equal Opportunities:

The AU Commission is an equal opportunity employer and qualified women are strongly encouraged to apply.

6. Remuneration

Indicative basic salary for this position is US\$ 14,852 (GSA5 Step 1) per annum plus other related entitlements such as post adjustment (46% of basic salary), Housing allowance US\$ 12,009.60 (per annum), education allowance (75% of tuition and other education related expenses for every eligible dependent up to a maximum of US\$7,800.00 per child per annum), etc. for internationally recruited staff of the Commission.
