Job Purpose;

To provide technical support to the division of Health, Nutrition and Population Division, to improve quality of data and information that is available on health, population and other related issues of regional, continental and global relevance.

Tasks

Major Duties and Responsibilities:

Under the direct supervision of the Director of Social Affairs and in close collaboration with the Heads of Division for Health, Population and Nutrition and Division of HIV/AIDS, the M&E Expert shall perform the following:

- Monitor, evaluate and prepare reports based on analysis of the statutory implementation of existing health and population policies, strategies, commitments and plan of action that have been adopted
- Develop monitoring & evaluation reporting tools on CARMMA and related Programs
- Develop M&E framework and harmonization of indicators for the Maputo PoA and Abuja Call as recommended by the executive Council and Assembly
- Provide technical expertise to the department for proper planning budgeting and reporting on implementation of the CARMMA initiative
- Assist in the management of the departmental data platform
- Assist with the work of the taskforce on MNCH established by the Assembly.
- Perform any other related duties as may be assigned

Requirements

Qualifications and Experience Requirements:

A Master's Degree in Health Sciences, Public Health, Medicine or other relevant Social Sciences including Health resources and Health Economics.

A minimum of seven (7) years of experience in Monitoring and Evaluation of Public Health policy related work with focus on Public Health in either/or both at national and international level. Knowledge and experience of the AU or UN systems is an added advantage.

OR

A University degree in Health Sciences, Public Health, Medicine or other relevant Social Sciences including Health resources. A minimum of ten (10) years of experience in Monitoring and Evaluation of Public Health policy related work with focus on control of Health in either/or both at national and international level. Knowledge

and experience of the AU or UN systems is an added advantage.

7. Tenure of Appointment:

The appointment will be made on a fixed term contract for a period of One (1) year, of which the first three months shall be considered as a probationary period. Thereafter, the contract will be renewable annually, subject to satisfactory performance, deliverables and the availability of funds.

9. Remuneration

The salary attached to the position is a fixed monthly lump sum of US\$ 6,922.50 (P3 Step5) inclusive of all allowances for internationally recruited staff, and US\$ 5,955.53 inclusive of all allowances for locally recruited staff.
